

Mild White Tea Body Wash

Phase A	Weight %	For 240 g / 8.5 oz
White Tea Infusion (diluent)	55.8 %	134 g / 4.8 oz
Guar Gum (thickener/conditioner)	1 %	2.4 g / 0.1 oz
EDTA (stabilizer/antioxidant)	0.2 %	0.5 g / 0.02 oz
Phase B		
Sulfosuccinate (cleansing agent)	22 %	53 g / 1.9 oz
Coco Betaine (cleansing agent)	10 %	24 g / 0.9 oz
Polyglucose (cleansing agent)	5 %	12 g / 0.4 oz
PEG-150 Distearate (thickener)	2 %	4.8 g / 0.2 oz
PEG-7 Glyceryl Cocoate (emulsifier/emollient)	3 %	7.2 g / 0.3 oz
Phase C		
Paraben-DU (preservative)	0.5 %	1.2 g / 0.04 oz (26 drops)
White Tea (fragrance)	0.5 %	1.2 g / 0.04 oz (26 drops)

Method

Make a tea infusion with hot distilled water using the herb white tea and let cool down to 100oF/40oC. Sprinkle the gum into the tea decoction and mix well until the gum is dissolved. Add EDTA and mix again. Add phase B one by one into a glass beaker and heat to 150F/65C to melt the peg-150 distearate. Combine phase A with phase B and stir gently. Add phase C to phase A/B and stir again until it is a homogenous solution.

Properties

Mild, herbal shower gel with white tea fragrance.
