PRIMARY ROUTES OF ENTRY: EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE: OVEREXPOSURE MAY AGGRAVATE EXISTING CONDITIONS: EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES:	SKIN CONTACT AND EYE CONTACT NO INFORMATION FOUND.  AGAIN. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION TO DETERMINE WHETHER VOMITING OR EVACUATION OF STOMACH IS NECESSARY. DO NOT GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS OR CONVULSING PERSON.
 INHALATION: REMOVE FROM AREA TO FRESH AIR. SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IF RESPIRATORY IRRITATION DEVELOPS OR IF BREATHING BECOMES DIFFICULT.

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IN CASE MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

SHOVEL SPILLS INTO APPROPRIATE CONTAINERS FOR DISPOSAL. TO REMOVE RESIDUE, WET WITH WATER, ABSORB WITH SAND OR VERMICULITE AND PLACE IN COMPATIBLE CONTAINER FOR DISPOSAL. KEEP OUT OF SEWERS AND OPEN BODIES OF WATER.

WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD:

DISPOSE OF IN COMPLIANCE WITH ALL FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS. INCINERATION IS THE PREFERRED METHOD.

SECTION VIII- PERSONAL PROTECTION INFORMATION

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION:

WHERE DUST OR PARTICULATES ARE GENERATED BY THE PROCESS A NIOSH/MSHA JOINTLY APPROVED RESPIRATOR IS ADVISED IN THE ABSENCE OF PROPER ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROLS.

VENTILATION TYPE:

OTHER PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:
