



## Easy Mineral Makeup Powder

(Sample Recipe for Mineral Base)

### Easy Mineral Makeup Powder

Phase A	Weight %	For 20 g / 0.7 oz
Mineral Base (powder base)	80 %	16 g / 0.7 oz/ 4 Tbsp
Pigment Blend Bare Neutral (or any other pigment blend with a different shade)	20 %	4 g / 0.15 oz/ 1/2 Tbsp

#### Method

Start with adding a little less than 1/2 Tbsp of Pigment Blend into a mortar (you can always add more later on if necessary). Then add 1 Tbsp of Mineral Blend to it and blend well with the pestle (use pressure to make sure it's well blended and there is no color streaking). Check the color. You can now add another Tbsp of Mineral Blend and mix again thoroughly with the pestle. Add as much Mineral Base until the color matches your skin tone. You can also use two different Pigment Blends, should the color not match your skin tone, maybe one red based and one yellow based. If you have added too much Mineral Base and the color is too light add some more of the Pigment Blend until the color seems right to you. Fill the Mineral Makeup into powder jars with sifter.

#### Properties

Loose mineral makeup with our Mineral Blend (contains titanium dioxide, mica powders and zinc oxide) mixed with a blend of iron oxide pigments. Adheres very well to the skin and gives a flawless natural look and velvet skin feel. Apply in layers for light, medium and full coverage.

Ethnic skin types should use less of the mineral base and much more of the pigment blend, about a 70/30 ratio (at least 70 pigment and 30 mineral base).

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
