### 4 FIRST AID MEASURES

## 6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

**Methods and material for containment and cleaning up:** Landfill solids at permitted area. Use registered transporters. Burn concentrated liquids, diluting with clean, low viscosity level. Avoid flame-outs. Assure emissions comply with applicable regulations. Dilute aqueous waste may biodegrade. Contaminated product soil, water, container residues, and spill cleanup materials should not be designated as hazardous wastes. Prevent flow to sewer/public waters. Spread granular cover. Soak up small spills with inert solids. Dispose of in compliance with Federal, State, and Local regulations. Contain/collect rapidly to minimize dispersion.
