Description: White tea, also known as Yinzhen, is produced predominately in Asia; it is picked just few days in spring when the white buds are young, withered and dried in natural sunlight and minimally processed to maintain its high concentration of polyphenols. Water-soluble. Appearance: Light to medium amber liquid, faint herbal odor. Contains 20% extract dissolved in water and glycerin, preserved with phenoxyethanol. Water-soluble.

Raw material source: Camellia sinensis (White Tea), glycerin made of naturally derived oils

Manufacture: Prepared via a cold process to avoid potential loss of effectiveness heat processing can have. Created from organically grown, pesticide-free materials which are extracted first with a specified eluant to yield a concentrate. This concentrate is then dissolved in glycerin and water at a concentration of 20 % concentrate and 80% diluents.
