## Lavender Hydrosol, USDA Certified Organic

**Description:** USDA certified organic distillate (hydrosol) from lavender flowers. A hydrosol is the aromatic water produced during the steam distilling process of plants & flowers. They have similar scents and functional properties as essential oils but are less concentrated. Clear to pale golden in color, medium intensity lavender scent. Water soluble.
