## Ashwagandha Extract

### Specification Sheet

**Description:** Natural extract obtained from the roots of the Ashwagandha plant dissolved in a base of glycerin and water, preserved with phenoxyethanol. Other common names are: Indian Ginseng or Winter Cherry). Light to medium amber liquid with characteristic odor. Water soluble.

**CAS:** 56-81-5, 7732-18-5, 90147-43-6, 122-99-6

**INCI Name:** Glycerin, water, Withania Somnifera (Ashwagandha) extract

**Benefits:**

- Has potent antioxidant properties, ideal for anti-aging products
- Moisturizes & conditions skin and scalp
- Nourishes & strengthens hair

**Use:** Add to formulas to the water phase. Typical use level 5 - 10%. For external use only.

**Applications:** Serums, creams & lotions, anti-aging products, sun- and after-sun care, hair care products.

**Country of Origin:** India

**Raw material source:** Ashwagandha plants, glycerin made from naturally derived oils

**Manufacture:** Prepared via a cold process to avoid potential loss of effectiveness heat processing can have. Created from organically grown, pesticide-free materials which are extracted first with a specified eluant to yield a concentrate. This concentrate is then dissolved in glycerin and water at a concentration of 20 % concentrate and 80% diluents.
