

Shea Butter Oil

Description: Shea Butter Oil is a lightweight, liquid shea derivative that provides skin-conditioning benefits while maintaining a smooth, non-waxy feel. Fluid at room temperature, it blends easily into emulsions and anhydrous systems, improving sensory experience.

Appearance: Slightly yellow, cloudy liquid

Benefits:

Use: 1-5% for skin care lotions and creams. 2-10% for lip care and lipsticks. 0.5-4% for hair care. For external use only.

Applications: Creams, lotions, serums, facial oils, body oils, massage products, hair conditioners, hair oils, balms, and anhydrous treatments

Solubility: Insoluble in water

Preservation: Preservative-free

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Protect from direct heat and light

Country of Origin: Sweden

Raw material source: Plant-derived, sourced from shea nuts (*Butyrospermum Parkii*), obtained via fractionation/extraction of shea butter to yield a liquid oil portion.



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Manufacture: Shea Butter Oil is manufactured by mechanically pressing and solvent-extracting the oil from shea seeds, followed by a series of refining steps to ensure purity. It is then fractionated to separate the liquid oil from solid components. A final deodorization step removes residual odors before the oil is packed for use in cosmetic formulations.

Animal Testing: Not animal tested.

GMO: GMO-free

Vegan: Does not contain animal-derived components.
