Amla Oil, USDA Certified Organic

Description: Known also as Indian gooseberry oil, amla oil is cold-pressed extracted from the seed of the *Emblica officinalis* plant. Unrefined. Very rich in antioxidants including vitamin C, flavonoids and polyphenols. Widely used in Ayurveda medicine. Yellowish brown liquid, characteristic aroma and flavor.
