Description: Quince (*Chaenomeles sinensis*) Fruit Extract is a botanical ingredient valued in cosmetic formulations for its antioxidant, moisturizing, and skin-conditioning properties. It is commonly used in facial skincare, body care, and hair care products.

Composition: Glycerin, Water, Chaenomeles Sinensis Fruit Extract, Phenoxyethanol

Appearance: Clear yellow liquid, with a characteristic odor

Benefits:

- May help calm dry or stressed skin
- Can contribute to smoother hair with improved shine

Use: Add to formulas during the water phase. Typical use level 0.5-5%, with 1-3% being typical for many skincare formulations. For external use only.

Solubility: Water-soluble

Preservation: Phenoxyethanol

Storage: Keep container tightly closed in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.
