Description: Organic Sea Buckthorn Fruit Oil is derived from the pulp of the Hippophae rhamnoides fruit, a highly priced European fruit. Contains a high content of natural Vitamin A, C, and E. Used in skin & hair care for its natural vitamin content and antioxidant properties. Increases skin elasticity and may help with free radical damage. The deep orange color is natural to this fruit.

Raw material source: Organic Hippophae Rhamniodes (Sea Buckthorn) fruit

Manufacture: The process begins by grinding organic sea buckthorn fruit. The oil is then extracted using supercritical CO₂ extraction (SFE), a gentle, solvent-free method that preserves its natural compounds. The crude oil is filtered, purified by molecular distillation at low temperature, and then packaged.
