

Sheer Lip Gloss Sugar Blush

(Sample Recipe Mica Sugar Blush)

Sheer Lip Gloss Sugar Blush		
Phase A	Weight %	For 50 g / 1.8 oz
Jojoba Gel (emollient)	72 %	36 g / 2 ½ Tbsp
Jojoba Oil (emollient)	25.4 %	12.7 g / 2 ½ tsp
Sugar Blush Mica	2 %	1 g / ½ tsp
Red 40 FD&C Lake	0.1 %	0.05 g / 1/8 tsp
Vitamin E Tocopherol (antioxidant)	0.2 %	0.1 g / 2 drops

Method

Food Flavoring (flavor)

Add phase A one by one into a glass beaker and stir well until uniform. Be aware that the Red 40 FD&C red is a very strong colorant and only very little is needed, maybe even less than 1/8 tsp. Start with just a tiny little bit, then add the sugar blush mica and test the shade. Adjust the color with mica as you wish. Fill the lip gloss into lip gloss containers with applicator, using a pipette or syringe. The lip gloss is very viscous to make it more liquid and therefore easier for bottling warm it to 50C/122F.

Properties

Jojoba Gel is a very viscous jojoba product with great sheer. Formulated with liquid jojoba, and vitamin E as antioxidant protection. The lip gloss can be used over lipstick or just as is.
