

Spring Colored Eye Shadow

(Sample Recipe for Ultramarine Pink)

| Spring Colored Eye-Shadow | | |
|--|----------|------------------|
| Phase A | Weight % | For 20 g /0.7 oz |
| Mineral Base | 81 % | 16.2 g / 0.6 oz |
| Magnesium Stearate | 5 % | 1 g / 1/2 tsp |
| Phase B | | |
| Ultramarine Pink | 4 % | 0.8 g / 1/4 tsp |
| Phase C | | |
| Mica Patina Silver | 10 % | 2 g / 1 tsp |
| Method | | |
| Give Phase A into a clean mortar and blend well with the pestle. | | |
| Add phase B to Phase A and blend well with the pestle or divide Phase A to make multiple colors. | | |
| When Phase C is added the pestle should not be used anymore. | | |
| Alternative colors are for example: ultramarine blue instead of the ultramarine pink or a combination of the two to create purple. | | |
| Diamond Cluster can also be used instead of the patina silver or in combination to give more sparkle. | | |
| The proportions of the colors can be changed, by adding more to create more intense shades or less for lighter pastel shades. | | |

| Loose eye shadow to be used with small shaker/sifter jars. | | |
